THIS BOOK IS ORIGINAL IN ITS CHARACTERIZATION OF THE MALE DEVELOPMENTAL TRAJECTORY AS UNDERPINNED BY PSYCHOANALYTIC PRINCIPLES PERTAINING TO CONFLICT AND INHERENT TENSIONS THAT CONTINUE THROUGHOUT THE LIFE CYCLE AND STRONGLY IMPACT OTHER AREAS OF LIFE. DEEPLY ROOTED IN THE UNCONSCIOUS, A MAN'S MULTIPLY DETERMINED SENSE OF MASCULINITY REQUIRES DECONSTRUCTING THE MOTHER, THE FEMININE, AND THE OTHER IN THE MALE PSYCHE. AS THE TEXT ILLUSTRATES VIA CLINICAL VIGNETTES, AN AWARENESS AND

AN UNDERSTANDING OF THESE AREAS CAN IMPROVE THE CLINICAL WORK OF PSYCHOANALYSTS WORKING WITH MEN WHO STRUGGLE WITH THE INTRINSIC CONFLICTS IN THEIR SENSE OF MALENESS. THIS BOOK WILL BE OF GREAT CLINICAL VALUE TO PSYCHOANALYSTS, PSYCHOTHERAPISTS AND OTHER MENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONERS, AND WILL STIMULATE THE THINKING OF SCHOLARS IN SUCH AREAS AS GENDER THEORY, PSYCHODYNAMIC AND SOCIOCULTURAL ASPECTS OF GENDER ROLES, AND THE CHANGING SOCIAL DEFINITION OF MASCULINITY.

THE GENDER VENDORS EXAMINES SEED-AND-SOIL IN THE CONTEXT OF THE PSYCHOLOGY OF GENDER, HONOR AND CHASTITY CODES, FEMALE GENITAL MUTILATION, THE TABOO ON MALE FEMININITY, FEMIPHOBIA (THE FEAR OF BEING FEMININE OR FEMINIZED), SEXUAL VIOLENCE, INSTITUTIONALIZED ABUSE, THE EARLY MODERN WITCH HUNTS, THE MEDICALIZATION AND CRIMINALIZATION OF GENDER NONCONFORMITY, AND CAMPAIGNS AGAINST WOMEN'S RIGHTS. THE EXAMINATION IS STRUCTURED AROUND PARTICULAR WATERSHEDS IN THE HISTORY OF SEED-AND-SOIL, FOR EXAMPLE, GENESIS, ANCIENT GREECE, EARLY CHRISTIANITY, THE MEDIEVAL CHURCH, THE EARLY MODERN EUROPEAN WITCH HUNTS, AND THE CAMPAIGNS OF THE NINETEENTH AND TWENTIETH CENTURIES AGAINST WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE AND EDUCATION. THE NEGLECTED STORY OF SEED-AND-SOIL MATTERS TO EVERYONE WHO CARES ABOUT GENDER EQUALITY AND WHY IT IS TAKING SO LONG TO ACHIEVE.

THIS MAY BE UNDERSTOOD AS BEING PARTLY DUE TO THE RELUCTANCE OF MALE SURVIVORS TO EXPOSE THEIR HISTORY OF ABUSE TO CLINICAL EYES. THIS MAY BE EXACERBATED BY A PARTICULAR BRAND OF MASCULINE SHAME THAT CAUSES MALE VICTIMS TO BE EVEN MORE SILENCED THAN FEMALE SURVIVORS. BASED ON THE AUTHOR'S EXTENSIVE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE OF WORKING WITH CHILDREN AND ADULT VICTIMS OF SEXUAL CRIME, *PSYCHOTHERAPY WITH MALE SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ABUSE* LOOKS AT THE LONG HISTORY OF MALE SEXUAL ABUSE, POSITIONING IT NOT SIMPLY AS A NEW PHENOMENON, BUT ONE THAT HAS A LONG BUT UNDOCUMENTED HISTORY. ANONYMISED CASE STUDIES PROVIDE THE BACKDROP FOR IN-DEPTH EXPLORATIONS OF VARIOUS CONSEQUENCES OF SEXUAL ABUSE, INCLUDING SEXUAL ADDICTION, PROFOUND DEPRESSION, GENDER DYSPHORIA, EATING DISORDERS, SELF

HARM, SUICIDAL IDEATION, AND DISSOCIATION.

HOW MIGHT THE VULNERABILITY OF LIFE AND THE UNPREDICTABILITY OF DESIRE LINK THEM TOGETHER? WHY HAS THE HUMAN/ANIMAL/PLANT HIERARCHY BEEN SO RIGIDLY, VIOLENTLY ENFORCED? NONHUMAN LIFE IMPASSIONED EVERY AREA OF *WARHOL*'S PRACTICE, BEGINNING WITH HIS JUVENILIA AND AN UNUSUALLY CLOSE CREATIVE COLLABORATION WITH HIS MOTHER, *JULIA WARHOLA*. THE PAIR CODEVELOPED A TRANSGRESSIVE ANIMALITY THAT PERMEATED *WARHOL*'S PROLIFIC CAREER, FROM HIS COMMERCIAL ILLUSTRATION AND EROTICA TO HIS WRITING AND, OF COURSE, HIS PAINTING, INSTALLATION, PHOTOGRAPHY, AND FILM. GRUDIN SHOWS THAT *WARHOL* DISPUTED THE TRADITIONAL CLAIM THAT CULTURE AND CREATIVITY DISTINGUISH THE HUMAN FROM THE MERELY ANIMAL AND VEGETAL, INSTEAD EXPLORING THE POSSIBILITY OF ART AS AN EARTHY AND ORGANIC FORCE, IMBUED WITH APPETITE AND DESIRE AT EVERY NODE. ULTIMATELY, BY ARGUING THAT NONHUMAN LIFE IS CENTRAL TO *WARHOL*'S WORK IN WAYS THAT MIRROR AND ANTICIPATE INFLUENTIAL TEXTS BY *TONI MORRISON* AND *OCEAN VUONG*, *LIKE A LITTLE DOG* OPENS AN ENTIRELY UNEXPLORED FIELD IN *WARHOL* SCHOLARSHIP.

FROM EXCLUSIONARY TO MULTIDISCIPLINARY, THE EVOLVING ROLE OF THE THERAPIST. AND AS CAN BE EXPECTED FROM THE AUTHOR, THERE IS SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON THE SUBLIME IN PSYCHOLOGY: THE PHILOSOPHY/PSYCHOLOGY FUSION OF THE NEW ENGLAND TRANSCENDENTALISTS, THE BATTLE BETWEEN SPIRITUALISM AND SCIENCE IN 1880S AMERICA, AND EARLY VERSIONS OF TODAY'S SPIRITUALLY-ATTUNED THERAPIES. PIVOTAL CONCEPTS AND KEY INDIVIDUALS COVERED ARE: *CHARCOT*, *JANET*, AND THE ORIGINS OF DYNAMIC PERSONALITY THEORY IN THE SO-CALLED FRENCH, SWISS, ENGLISH, AND AMERICAN PSYCHOTHERAPEUTIC AXIS. AND IN WHAT WAYS HAS THE ABSURD STANCE CONTINUED TO SHAPE POSTMODERN THOUGHT AND CONTEMPORARY CULTURE? IN *RETHINKING THE POLITICS OF ABSURDITY*, *MATTHEW H. BOWKER'S BOOK WILL BE OF INTEREST TO SCHOLARS AND PRACTITIONERS IN THE FIELDS OF POLITICAL SCIENCE, PHILOSOPHY, LITERATURE, PSYCHOANALYSIS, SOCIOLOGY, AND CULTURAL STUDIES.

IN THE UNITED STATES MISCEGENATION IS NOT MERELY A SUBJECT OF LITERATURE AND POPULAR CULTURE. IT IS IN MANY WAYS THE FOUNDATION OF CONTEMPORARY IMAGINARY COMMUNITY. JANE ADDAMS, PAULINE HOPKINS, ONOTO WATANNA (WINNIFRED EATON), MARÍA CRISTINA MENA, AND MOURNING DOVE (CHRISTINE QUINTASKET) EMBRACED THE IMAGES OF THE UNITED STATES—AND INCREASINGLY THE WORLD—AS AN INTERRACIAL NUCLEAR FAMILY. THEY ALSO REFRAMED PUBLIC DEBATES THROUGH NARRATIVES DEPICTING INTERRACIAL ENCOUNTERS AS LONGSTANDING, UNACKNOWLEDGED LIAISONS BETWEEN WHITE MEN AND RACIALIZED WOMEN THAT PRODUCED AN INCESTUOUS, MIXED-RACE NATION. BY MOBILIZING THE SEXUAL TABOOS OF INCEST AND MISCEGENATION, THESE WOMEN WRITERS CREATED POLITICAL ALLEGORIES OF KINSHIP AND COMMUNITY. THROUGH THEIR CRITICISMS OF THE NATION'S HISTORY OF EXPLOITATION AND COLONIZATION, THEY ALSO IMAGINED A MORE INCLUSIVE FUTURE. AS JOLIE A. ALCHEMICAL MERCURY MOVES FROM ANTIQUITY, THROUGH THE GOLDEN AGE OF ALCHEMY IN THE

DUTCH SEVENTEENTH CENTURY, TO CONCEPTUAL ART, TO ALTERNATIVE FUELS, STOPPING TO THINK WITH WRITERS SUCH AS DANTE, GOETHE, HOFFMANN, THE GRIMM BROTHERS, GEORGE ELIOT, AND MARX. ECLECTIC AND WIDE-RANGING, THIS IS THE FIRST STUDY TO CONSIDER ALCHEMY IN RELATION TO LITERARY AND VISUAL THEORY IN A COMPREHENSIVE WAY.

USING 1818 AS A STARTING POINT, ALSTON INVESTIGATES FAMILIES IN CHILDREN'S LITERATURE AT THEIR MOST INTIMATE, FOCUSING ON HOW THEY SHARE THEIR SPACES, THEIR IDEALS OF HOME, AND EVEN ON WHAT THEY EAT FOR DINNER. WHAT EMERGES FROM ALSTON'S STUDY ARE NOT SO MUCH THE CONTRASTS THAT EXIST BETWEEN PERIODS, BUT RATHER THE STARTLING SIMILARITIES OF THE IDEOLOGY OF FAMILY INTRINSIC TO CHILDREN'S LITERATURE. THE FAMILY IN ENGLISH CHILDREN'S LITERATURE SHEDS LIGHT ON WHO MAINTAINS CONTROL, WHO BEHAVES, AND HOW SIGNIFICANT CHILDREN'S LITERATURE IS IN SHAPING OUR IDEAS ABOUT WHAT MAKES A FAMILY "GOOD."

THE FIRST-PERSON NARRATORS AND CHARACTERS THAT POPULATE COBAIN'S TEXTS UNDERSCORE THE POLITICAL AND AESTHETIC REPERCUSSIONS OF HIS ART. COBAIN'S DISTINCTIVE VERSION OF GRUNGE, UNDERSTOOD AS A SUBCULTURE, A LITERARY GENRE, AND A CULTURAL PRACTICE, REPRESENTS A SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE OF RACE AND GENDER, ONE THAT FACILITATES AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE SELF AS PART OF A LARGER SOCIAL ORDER. SAINT-AUBIN APPROACHES COBAIN'S WRITINGS INDEPENDENTLY OF THE ARTIST'S BIOGRAPHY, POSITIONING THESE TEXTS WITHIN THE TRADITION OF POSTMODERN REPRESENTATIONS OF MASCULINITY IN TWENTIETH-CENTURY AMERICAN FICTION, WHILE ALSO SUGGESTING CONNECTIONS TO EUROPEAN ROMANTIC TRADITIONS FROM THE NINETEENTH CENTURY THAT POSTULATE A RELATION BETWEEN MELANCHOLY (OR DEPRESSION) AND CREATIVITY. IN TURN, THROUGH SAINT-AUBIN'S ELEGANT ANALYSIS, COBAIN'S CREATIVE WRITINGS ILLUMINATE CONTRADICTIONS AND INCONSISTENCIES WITHIN PSYCHOANALYTIC THEORY ITSELF CONCERNING THE INTERSECTION OF MASCULINITY, MASOCHISM, MELANCHOLY, AND THE DEATH DRIVE.
